

Curriculum

POLICY AND PROCEDURES

SCOPE:

This policy applies to all teachers at Hallam Primary School.

RATIONALE:

The Australian Curriculum in Victoria, AusVELS (Australian Victorian Essential Learning Standards) provides the framework for curriculum development from Foundation to Year 10 at Hallam Primary School.

AIMS:

- To use AusVELS and a range of supporting curriculum options to develop and provide education programs that are meaningful for students.
- To provide a whole school curriculum from Foundation to Year Six.

GUIDELINES FOR ACTION:

- The Department provides resources and support to assist Hallam Primary School in implementing the AusVELS curriculum. These resources include:
 - Principles of Learning and Teaching P-12 (PoLT)
 - Curriculum Planning Guidelines
 - Assessment Advice
 - Student Report Cards.
- Units of Inquiry are delivered via Unit Hero, an online planning tool (see Unit Hero Policy).
- The Unit Hero concepts include Community, Sustainability, Social Justice, Creativity, Identity, Change, Necessity and Curiosity.
- The VCAA and ACARA websites will be used to support the implementation of AusVELS and Unit Hero.
- Each semester, modules will develop comprehensive Unit of Inquiry, Mathematics and English planning documents.
- Online learning programs will also form a part of the curriculum.
- School Council will oversee and approve curriculum direction and AusVELS implementation.
- The community will be kept informed of the curriculum, via the school website, notices, newsletter items, parent teacher forums, and updates of school progress in implementing and assessing AusVELS will be made available.
