Learning@Home

Students will continue with *Learning@Home* until at least next Thursday 2 September. Schools are awaiting further advice from the government in relation to the end of the current lockdown period. *Learning@Home* materials for next week will be available for collection on Friday 27 August.

All students are expected to attend their daily, online classroom meetings, and all students should now be working through their *Learning@Home* materials for this week...Monday (23rd), Tuesday (24th), Wednesday (25th), Thursday (26th) and Friday (27th).

Completed *Learning@Home* materials can be dropped into the school's letter box at Gate 2 when you're collecting next week's materials or whenever you're coming past the school. This will enable teachers to review students' work and provide feedback. Staff are planning materials for another week, just in case, however we are hoping we can all be back on site at Hallam PS sooner rather than later.

We are here to assist so please don't hesitate to contact the school if you have questions about your child's learning tasks or any technical difficulties.

Onsite Attendance

Information is available on the school's website or by contacting the school. **There are specific eligibility requirements for approval of onsite attendance.**

CovidSafety

Masks must be worn indoors and outdoors by adults and children over 12 years of age except if at home or if an exception applies.

It is now recommended that children under 12 years of age and students at primary school wear face masks when at school, when attending an OHSC program, when travelling to and from school on public transport and when in taxis or ride share vehicles.

With exposure sites continuing to grow, the Hallam PS community is reminded to remain vigilant in relation to the highly infectious Delta variant.

CovidSafety behaviours include: wearing a mask, QR check-in everywhere you visit (no matter how long you spend at that location), maintaining 1.5 metres from others and getting vaccinated when you're eligible. **If you have any symptoms, no matter how mild, you must get tested for COVID-19.**

There is no COVID-19 vaccination program currently operating in Victorian schools. Eligible children 12 years or older can access a COVID-19 vaccination from a State vaccination centre or participating GP or community health service.
