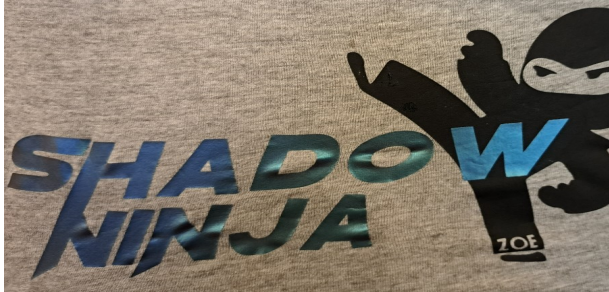

My gym had a competition and I got 2nd place. I get the chance to go to America in Orlando for a competition to compete with kids all over the world.

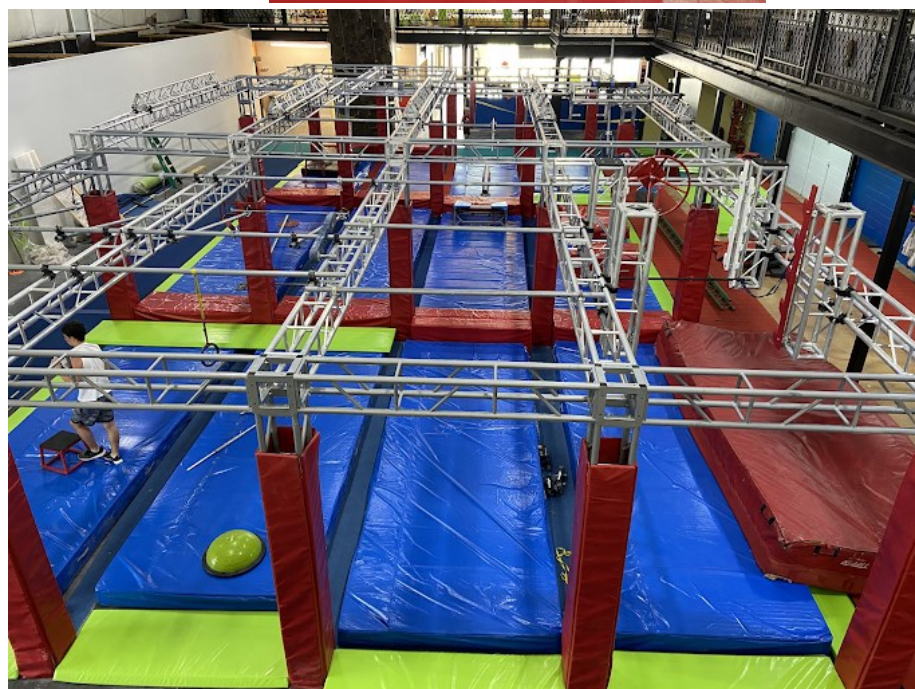
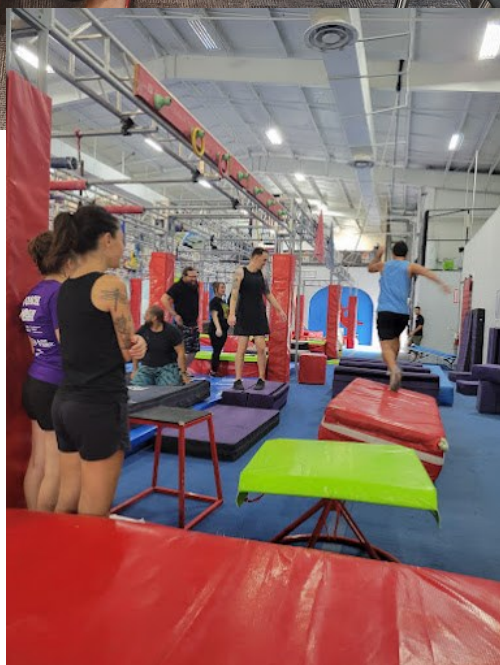
Who's going with you to America?

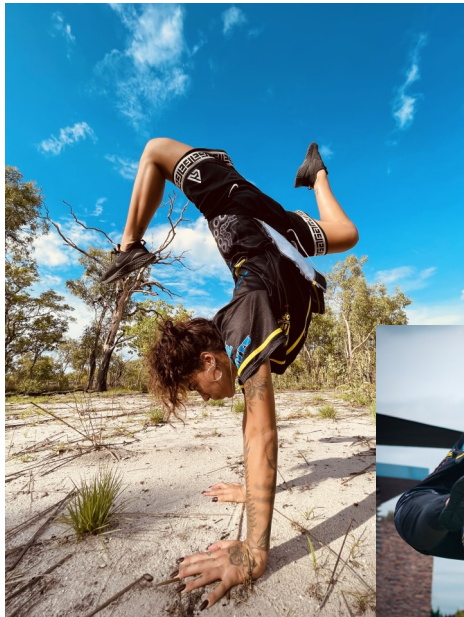
AFL Victoria Primary Play Program

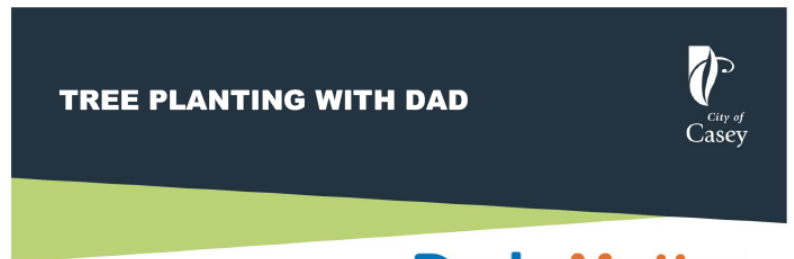

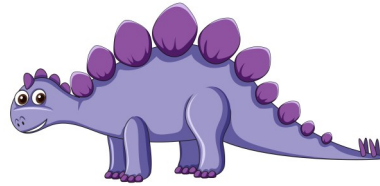

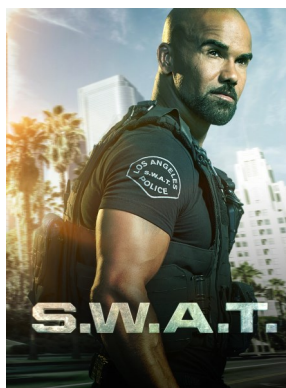
