Student Accident Insurance and Ambulance Cover Arrangements

Parents are reminded that neither the Department of Education (DE) nor Hallam Primary School provide personal accident insurance or ambulance cover for students. Parents/carers are responsible for the cost of medical treatment for injured students, including transport costs.

Student accident insurance policies are available from the private insurance market. These cover a range of medical expenses not covered by Medicare. They can be obtained by parents/carers for individual students.

Personal Belongings at School

Private property bought to Hallam Primary School by students, staff or visitors is not insured and the DE is not responsible for any loss or damage. This can include, but is not limited to, mobile phones, devices, sporting equipment, toys and jewellery.

School Saving Bonus (SSB)

Parents have advised Hallam PS Administration staff that they have been very confused about the School Saving Bonus (SSB) process. Consequently, many have sought assistance with this process.

Parents are responsible for the allocation of funds using the SSB Portal. If parents need assistance they should come to the office where staff can help them with the online allocation process. School programs cannot be paid without completing the online allocation of funds.
