














Science Week

As part of Science Week, our school held four open afternoons where Prep, Year 1/2, Year 3/4, and Year 5/6 students invited their parents into the STEM room to share in their learning. Families took part in a wide range of hands-on activities, including LEGO WeDo 2.0 to test earthquake-proof buildings, exploring the properties of rocks, and using a torch and globe to model night and day. Other highlights included sorting everyday materials, viewing class science journals, creating designs in Tinkercad for 3D printing, experimenting with Little Alchemy 2, ScratchJr, and Makey Makey, as well as investigations such as Snap, Tear or Stretch and Bend it, Stretch it or Scrunch it. Parents and students also enjoyed building cars with LEGO SPIKE Education, designing playdough animals and their habitats, and exploring patterns in the natural world using natural items. It was wonderful to see so many families and Hallam PS staff getting involved and enjoying science learning together.





\$100 Power Saving Bonus – Community Outreach Program

Power Saving Bonus Program

The Power Saving Bonus is a \$100 payment providing real help to address the cost of living and drive down energy bills for Victorians in need. Victorian households with an eligible concession card can visit the Victorian Energy Compare website - compare.energy.vic.gov.au - to apply online or apply through the Community Outreach Program.

Eligibility criteria

To be eligible, households will need to:

- · Have a recent residential electricity bill
- · Hold one of the following concession cards:
 - Health Care Card
 - Pensioner Concession Card
 - Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card
 - Veterans' Affairs Gold Card
- · Only one payment per household is available.
